

Tasks of Parish/School Safe Environment Teams

- 1. Be formed to implement the Safe Environment Program.
 - Attend Safe Environment Team training
 - Read and understand the Code of Conduct for Church Personnel in the Diocese of Raleigh (Code of Conduct)
 - Learn and study issues relevant to the work of the committee by accessing the <u>Diocese of Raleigh</u> website. Resources include: child abuse prevention, reporting suspected abuse, parish resources and helpful checklists.
- 2. Ensure *Code of Conduct* is read and understood by all Church personnel (staff and volunteers of parishes and schools)
 - Make Diocesan *Code of Conduct* readily available to all Church personnel
 - Offer assistance to Church personnel to ensure they understand the *Code of Conduct*.
- 3. Assist Supervisors in screening all church personnel
 - Provide resources, strategies to Church personnel how to conduct interviews
 - Provide resources, strategies, and assistance to Church personnel on how to conduct reference checks. Ensure that reference checks are entered into the EAppsDB system.
 - Provide resources to Church personnel to assist with **timely completion** of the criminal background checks procedures. This includes the completion of forms, checking of references as well as recording and filing these forms.
- 4. Serve as liaison for the Diocesan Office of Child and Youth Protection (OCYP)
 - Communicate information between the Diocesan OCYP and the parish/school, this includes using data from social media posts, emailed newsletters, and the website resources to communicate with parishioners and enhance local ministry efforts.
 - Maintain accurate communication links (updated emails and phone numbers) with the Office of Child and Youth Protection
 - Attending at least one meeting annually (in person or webinar) that is hosted by the Office of Child and Youth Protection. (Deanery leadership meetings are held every February/March)
 - Seek and offer advice regarding the implementation of the Safe Environment Program for your parish and/or school (call 1-866-535-7233 or email SET.support@raldioc.org)
- 5. Design and implement educational and awareness strategies for parish and/or school
 - Establish a recurring training program on the topic of recognizing and reporting abuse for all new church personnel and those needing training renewal
 - Encourage participation in webinar based Safe Environment Training
 - Provide training for deepening the awareness and response of abuse
 - Ensure parenting education and resources available at your site
 - Distribute flyers, brochures that raise awareness and call to action
 - Encourage participation in or sponsorship of Prevent Child Abuse Month activities (April of each vear)
 - Offer prayer services, homily hints, prayers of the faithful, etc. periodically to foster reconciliation, healing, awareness, and growth
