Every year, through our Diocesan Office of Child and Youth Protection, over 2,000 adults receive training on how to recognize and report suspected child abuse and neglect. This training prepares us to respond when a young person is in need or requires extra care and protection. Our clergy, consecrated religious, staff, catechists and volunteers serve as a witness to our commitment to this important endeavor.

We have been given the gift of our Catholic Christian faith and the gift of caring for children. May the Holy Family continue to watch over us and guide us in this work, in union with the Heart of Our Lord Jesus, now and always.
