_____ No criminal charges have ever been brought against him nor does he have a criminal record.

_____ He has never behaved in such a manner as to indicate that he might engage in sexual behavior inconsistent with
his status.

_____ He has never behaved in such a way as to indicate that he might deal with minors in an inappropriate manner.

_____ He does not have a current, untreated alcohol or substance abuse problem.

_____ He does not have a current, untreated emotional or mental health problem.

_____ He has, as mandated by the *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People*, participated in a *Virtus* or
Presidium or other approved training session on how to provide a safe environment for children and young people.

_____ He has never been involved in any incident, to my knowledge, which called into question his fitness or suitability to
fulfill the responsibilities and duties of his ministry.

_____ He is a person fully qualified to serve as an effective speaker in union with the Magisterium of the Catholic Church
with respect to faith and morals

and reputation and is qualified to serve as a deacon in an effective and suitable manner. I hereby grant him permission to seek to
