*Some Additional Marian Devotions Include:

- Recitation of the Little Office of the Blessed Virgin
- Regular Recitation of the Angelus / Regina Caeli
- Recitation of the Litany of Loreto
- Recitation of the Little Crown of Our Lady, as recommended by St. Louis De Montfort
- Hourly devotions (e.g. saying a Hail Mary each time the clock strikes a new hour)
- Beginning all actions with a Hail Mary
- Frequently invoking the Holy Name of Mary (e.g. "Mary!", "Hail Mary", etc.)
- Meditating on the Joys of Mary Engaging in appropriate charitable acts, works, mortifications, fasts, etc. in honor of Mary

[especially during days/months devoted to the Blessed Virgin (e.g. Saturdays/May)].

- Other Marian chaplets, prayers, etc.
- Other exercises of devotion in honor of the Immaculate Virgin Mary
- Offer up Communions, novenas, etc in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary
- Veneration of an image
- Join appropriate Marian confraternities
- Participate in Marian pilgrimages
- Engaging in appropriate spiritual reading
- Make special offerings of charity or other good acts on Marian Feast days




